LOCAL LEVEL PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Most local level courses are offered in conjunction with the Pennsylvania State Fire Academy and/or an Educational Training Agency. All programs are conducted at the Indiana County Fire Academy facility and do not include meals or course materials, unless indicated. For full course descriptions refer to the State Fire Academy Course Catalogue, Local Level Course Section.

The following policies apply to all programs offered by the Academy:

1. Students must meet the age requirement established by the State Fire Academy by the starting date of the program. Proof of age can be required and should be available upon request.
2. Students with facial hair will not be permitted to participate in programs requiring the use of breathing apparatus per PSFA standards.
3. Students will be required to provide their own classroom materials, personal protection equipment, including breathing apparatus, work clothes and safety equipment as required for the program.
4. **Students are required to provide proof that the prerequisite training has been completed.** This must be a copy of the prerequisite course certificate of completion or attendance.
5. Students will be notified by mail of specific course information upon registration. A minimum number of students shall be required for any program. Programs will be cancelled for programs not meeting the required safe minimums.
6. **Site fees must be paid in advance to guarantee placement in the program and to take advantage of the discount price for the class. Site fees not paid by the first night of the class, will be for the regular price listed for the class.** Site fees not paid by the completion of the course will delay receipt of certification by the student and will be subject to a monthly interest charge.
7. Site fees will be refunded if a program is canceled. **If you are unable to attend a course after registration, your cancellation must be received prior to the first program date to guarantee a refund or to guarantee that you are not billed as a student of the class.**
8. Certification documents will be provided through US mail to each student successfully completing a program. Time attendance records will be provided upon request.
9. Registration deadlines for all programs are one week prior to the listed starting date unless otherwise indicated on the course outline.
10. All students will be required to complete a release from injury form prior to beginning any program at the Indiana County Public Safety Training Academy.

SITE RENTAL INFORMATION

The Indiana County Public Safety Academy is available to be rented by agencies wishing to hold their own in-house training for their members. In order to keep the academy financially viable, fees are assessed for certain items and for programs sponsored at the site by outside agencies or organizations. The charter member departments of the "Fire Chief's Association of Indiana County" who's dues are in good standing, have free use of the site and will be assessed fees for the cost of consumable goods used. Industrial brigades, response teams or private sector safety departments, wishing to have courses provided to them at the site, can make arrangements to have courses scheduled and presented for their personnel. Catering services are available and can be purchased directly through the academy. PA State Fire Academy In-Station Training

The PA State Fire Academy also offers certain classes at your fire station. These classes are free of charge and are scheduled directly through the state fire academy.

Classes available from the Alternative Energy Emergency Response (AEER) Training Program of the Pennsylvania State Fire Academy

1. **"Wellsite Emergency First Responder" (WEFR)** – 6 hours: The program describes the activities that are normally a part of a Marcellus Shale Gas Field project and some of the emergencies that could occur at or near the site. Subjects include well site selection and preparation, rigging up and well construction, completing the well and rigging down, the production phase including typical equipment found on a pad in production, and the role of the emergency responder. Past emergency incidents from gas pads are reviewed and discussed.
2. **"Wellsite Production Phase Emergencies" (WPPE)** – 2 hours: *PRIMARILY FOR PERSONS THAT PREVIOUSLY ATTENDED THE 4-HOUR WEFR CLASS.* The program describes additional activities that are normally a part of a Marcellus Shale Gas well in the production phase, and some of the emergencies that could occur at or near a gas well site. Subjects include the typical equipment seen in the production phase at a well site, emergency incidents that have occurred at or near sites, and the role of the emergency responder.
3. **"Firefighting at Shale Gas Emergencies" (FSGE)** – 16 hours: Students attending this course will become familiar with the history of drilling and shale layers in PA, well site emergencies, extinguishing agents, firefighting techniques, and the roles and responsibilities of first responders. Classroom delivery includes our "Wellsite Emergency First Responder" class as well as additional information. Outside activities on Day 2 include a gas industry vehicle demonstration/explanation, hose line drills, and live-fire exercises including foam application.
4. **"Responding To Ethanol Incidents" (RTEI)** – 7 hours: This class utilizes curriculum from the International Association of Fire Chiefs that covers a host of issues, including ethanol and blended fuels, transportation of ethanol blended fuels, storage and dispensing and firefighting foam principles for ethanol blended fuels. Traditional methods of firefighting against hydrocarbon (gasoline) fires have been found to be ineffective against these polar solvent-type (ethanol-blended) fuels.
5. **"Foam – Ethanol Technician Level I" (FEUT)** – 8 hours: This program covers a host of issues, including foam equipment, foam application, types of foam and provides an opportunity to utilize the latest foam equipment. This class is an excellent follow-up program to the "Responding To Ethanol Incidents" (RTEI) Class but can be scheduled as a stand-alone program.
6. **"WWCI Hazardous Materials Technician" (WWHMT)** – 40 hours: This 5-day class will help to prepare responders to be in charge of a hazmat incident, to organize and direct an effective response, to develop the Responders' ability to pre-plan for Hazmat Emergencies, improve the capability of their internal response organization and inform Responders of the regulatory requirements governing management of hazmat incidents. This course complies with OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120(q). This class does not include certification testing.
7. **"WWCI Hazardous Material Technician Refresher" (WWHMTR)** – 16 hours: This 2-day course covers the skills and competencies that are required to be successful in the role of a hazardous materials technician in gas field emergencies. Students receive the critical knowledge to safely respond to multiple types of hazardous materials emergencies. Course topics cover aspects ranging from role definition on to implementing contingency plans. This course complies with OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120(q). This class does not include certification testing.
8. **"Pipeline Emergencies Awareness Training" (PEAT)** - 4 hours: Students attending this program will easily identify the key players who may respond to a pipeline emergency, primary causes of pipeline incidents, and basic pipeline operations.
9. **"Pipeline Emergencies Operations Training" (PEOT)**- 8 hours: This program will identify the key players who may respond to a pipeline emergency, primary causes of pipeline incidents, basic pipeline operations, properties of products transported via pipelines, as well as pipeline markers and the types of pipelines. Numerous scenarios are used to challenge attendees.
