Indiana County Public Safety Training Academy Scheduled Programs – July to December 2025 Local Level, Suppression and Non-Suppression Programs:

All County 1st Responders;

The information on program offerings at the Indiana County Public Safety Academy are intended for you to gain experience and knowledge in basic response techniques and skills. These program offerings are developed and delivered in line with the State Fire Academy "Local Level" course offerings. If there is a program that you would like to have offered, from the State Local Level course listing, please feel free to contact us and we will make every effort to provide that program.

Throughout the fall the Academy continues to offer the State Fire Academy's "NEW" HAZMAT Programs, along with the Passenger Vehicle Rescue series. Updated Certification testing that align with these programs are also scheduled. Also on during the schedule period, the NEW Rope Rescue series and Confined Space Rescue series, along with Certification are available.

Remember that if you wish to register 17 year olds in the Interior Fire Fighter and Fire Fighter I Certification Testing, the ACT-155 permission slip must be submitted for these students. Permission slips must be provided for participation and can be obtained from our website. These ACT-155 permission slips can be submitted with course registration or provided directly to the lead instructor for the program.

Scheduling of staff and program delivery is based on pre-registration. If the minimum numbers of students needed for a program to be safely run are not met by the course deadline, the program cannot be offered. IT IS IMPORTANT TO GET YOUR REGISTRATION SUBMITTED BY THE DEADLINE, 2-WEEKS PRIOR TO THE CLASS, TO GUARANTEE THAT THE COURSE WILL RUN.

Processing student registration is being handled via email. A PDF fillable and printable application is available on our website. Legibility of your personal email is extremely important as all communications regarding courses will be sent directly to the registered student. Also, course completion certificates will be sent via email, to the student, State law prohibits us from sending certificates to anyone other than the student who obtained it.

Textbooks for each program will be required, similar to the current Essentials program. The Academy maintains an account with Lancaster County Fireman's Assoc. for procurement of books, we can purchase in bulk and provide the books for you at cost. Textbooks for the HAZMAT Awareness and Operations programs are available for loan from the Academy, thanks to a stockpile provided by PEMA for student use.

It is also imperative that any listed pre-requisite course certificates be provided with student registration forms. If you do not have the pre-requisite courses required to register for a program, a certificate of completion cannot be issued to the student upon completion.

LOCAL LEVEL PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Most Local level courses are offered in conjunction with the Pennsylvania State Fire Academy. For additional information on specific courses or for registration information contact the Academy Office at **724-349-9300 or E-mail:** <u>ICPSA@indianacounty.org</u> All programs are conducted at the Indiana County Public Safety Academy facility, located at: **529 Fire Academy Road in Homer City, PA. 15923** and do not include meals or course materials, unless indicated. For full course descriptions refer to the State Fire Academy, Local Level Course Catalogue on their website.

The following policies apply to all programs offered by the Academy:

- 1. Students must meet the age requirement established by the State Fire Academy by the starting date of the program. Proof of age can be required and should be available upon request.
- 2. Students with facial hair will not be permitted to participate in programs requiring the use of breathing apparatus per PSFA standards.
- 3. Students will be required to provide their own classroom materials, personal protection equipment, including breathing apparatus, work clothes and safety equipment as required for the program.
- 4. **Students are required to provide proof that the prerequisite training has been completed.** A copy of the pre-requisite certificate must be included with the submission of the course registration form to be accepted into the program.
- 5. Students will be notified by e-mail of specific course information upon registration. A minimum number of students shall be required for any program. Programs will be cancelled, also by email notification, if the minimum number of students for the class to run safely is not met.
- 6. Site fees must be paid in advance to guarantee placement in the program and to take advantage of the discount price for the class. Site fees not paid by the first night of the class, will be invoiced at regular price listed for the class. Site fees not paid by the completion of the course will delay receipt of certification by the student and will be subject to a monthly interest charge.
- 7. Indiana County residents affiliated with municipal or county governments can take advantage of the LEPC HAZMAT Grant programs. Student registration fees are paid by the grant. If you register and fail to show for the class or fail to withdraw from the class, you will be responsible to pay the full amount for the course registration.
- 8. Site fees will be refunded if a program is canceled. If you are unable to attend a course after registration, your cancellation must be received prior to the first program date to guarantee a refund or to guarantee that you are not billed as a student of the class.
- 9. Certification documents will be provided to each student successfully completing a program. Time attendance records will be provided upon request.
- 10. Registration deadlines for all classes are <u>**TWO WEEKS**</u> prior to the listed starting date unless otherwise indicated on the course outline. Application submission deadlines for certification examinations is <u>**THREE WEEKS**</u> prior to the date of the exam.
- 11. All students will be required to complete a release from injury form prior to beginning any program at the Indiana County Public Safety Training Academy.
- 12. All fees not paid in 30 days will receive an additional charge of 5% per month overdue penalty fee.
- 13. Credit Card payments are subject to a 5% service fee for processing.
