First Responders;

Celebrating the 50th Year of Public Safety Training in Indiana County has so far been a very busy year. In 1976, the Fire Chief's Association of Indiana County began delivery of training programs for Fire Departments within and adjoining to Indiana County. These formative years were done in an annual weekend delivery, where several programs were offered simultaneously. In 1977, the winter offerings of the Basic Fire Fighter course were held at the Homer City Fire Station. We are proud to continue this tradition of offering local level training programs to our first responder community.

The information on program offerings, at the Indiana County Public Safety Academy, are intended for you to gain experience and knowledge in basic response techniques and skills. These program offerings are developed and delivered in line with the Pa. State Fire Academy "Local Level" course offerings. If there is a program that you would like to have offered, from the State Local Level course listing, please feel free to contact us and we will make every effort to provide that program.

Please visit our website for the most up to date information on course offerings, PDF fillable documents, course cancellations, and general information on site use, course requests for delivery at your station or any other information related to our facility. The website can be found from any search engine; Indiana County Public Safety Academy or by entering icpsa.indianacounty.org.

Starting with this schedule of course offerings the new series of essentials training, the EL-26 programs are scheduled to start July 21, 2026. These programs are consistent with the State's requirements for Fire Ground Support, Fire Fighter I and Fire Fighter II, with Pro-Board / IFSAC Certification testing offered for each level. These new program offerings will also come with a change in student textbooks, moving to the *Fundamentals of Firefighter Skills, 5th Edition, Jones and Bartlett*.

To guarantee the most efficient processing of course registrations and issuance of course certificates, we must have a valid email address for each and every student in the program. A PDF fillable and printable application is available on our website. Please email your completed course registration forms to icpsa@indianacounty.org for quick registration in local level training. If you are going to mail your application, please send it to ICPSA, 85 Haven Dr, Indiana PA, 15701. Applications mailed directly to the Academy's Homer City address can be delayed. Course registration notification, as well as course completion certificates, will be sent via email to each student. Students can keep the digital copy and forward copies to their department or anywhere else they may be needed. State law prohibits us from sending completion certificates to anyone other than the student.

All students registering for courses at ICPSA require the students to be registered in the PSFA ACADIS Learning Management System. This system will also be used for access to Certification Testing applications, as well as historical documentation of your completed training programs. Note: Bucks Co. Community College courses and certification do not appear on the States ACADIS platform, therefore, hardcopies of these documents will still be required to be presented as pre-requisites or co-requisites for course registration. Registration on ACADIS also requires that you obtain a FEMA SID number. If you do not have a FEMA SID or don't remember your number, please keep your card handy for reference.

LOCAL LEVEL PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Most local level courses are offered in conjunction with the Pennsylvania State Fire Academy. For additional information on specific courses or for registration information contact the Academy Office at **724-349-9300** or by email to icpsa@indianacounty.org. All programs are conducted at the Indiana County Public Safety Academy facility, which is located at: **529 Fire Academy Road in Homer City, PA. 15748**. **Course fees do not** include meals or course materials, unless indicated. For full course descriptions refer to the State Fire Academy, Local Level Course Catalogue on their website.

The following policies apply to all programs offered by the Academy:

1. Students must meet the age requirement established by the State Fire Academy by the starting date of the program. Proof of age is required and should be available upon request.
2. Students with facial hair will not be permitted to participate in programs requiring the use of breathing apparatus per PSFA standards.
3. Students will be required to provide their own classroom materials, personal protection equipment, including breathing apparatus, work clothes and safety equipment as required for the program.
4. **Students are required to provide proof that the prerequisite training has been completed.** A copy of the pre-requisite certificate **MUST** be provided with the submission of the course registration form or to the lead instructor, for issuance of a course certificate upon completion.
5. Students will be notified by e-mail of specific course information upon registration. A minimum number of students is required for any program. Programs will be cancelled, also by email notification, if the minimum number of students for the class to run safely is not met.
6. **Site fees must be paid in advance to guarantee placement in the program and to take advantage of the discount price for the class. Site fees not paid by the first night of the class, will be invoiced at regular price listed for the class.** Site fees not paid by the completion of the course will delay receipt of certification by the student and will be subject to a monthly interest charge.
7. Indiana County residents affiliated with municipal or county governments can take advantage of the Indiana County LEPC, HAZMAT Grant programs. Student registration fees are paid by the grant for programs offered at the Academy site. If you register and fail to show for the class or fail to withdraw from the class, you will be responsible to pay the full amount for the course registration.
8. Site fees will be refunded if a program is canceled. **If you are unable to attend a course after registration, your cancellation must be received prior to the first program date to guarantee a refund or to guarantee that you are not billed as a student of the class.**
9. Certification documents will be provided to each student successfully completing a program. Time attendance records will be provided upon request.
10. Registration deadlines for all Local Level programs are **TWO WEEKS** prior to the listed starting date unless otherwise indicated on the course outline.
11. All students will be required to complete a Student Information Form and Acknowledgement of Code of Conduct from at the beginning any program at the Indiana County Public Safety Training Academy. This form also requires the acknowledgement of an officer of your sponsoring department.
12. All fees not paid in 30 days will receive an additional charge of 5% per month overdue penalty fee.
13. Credit Card payments are subject to a 5% service fee for processing.

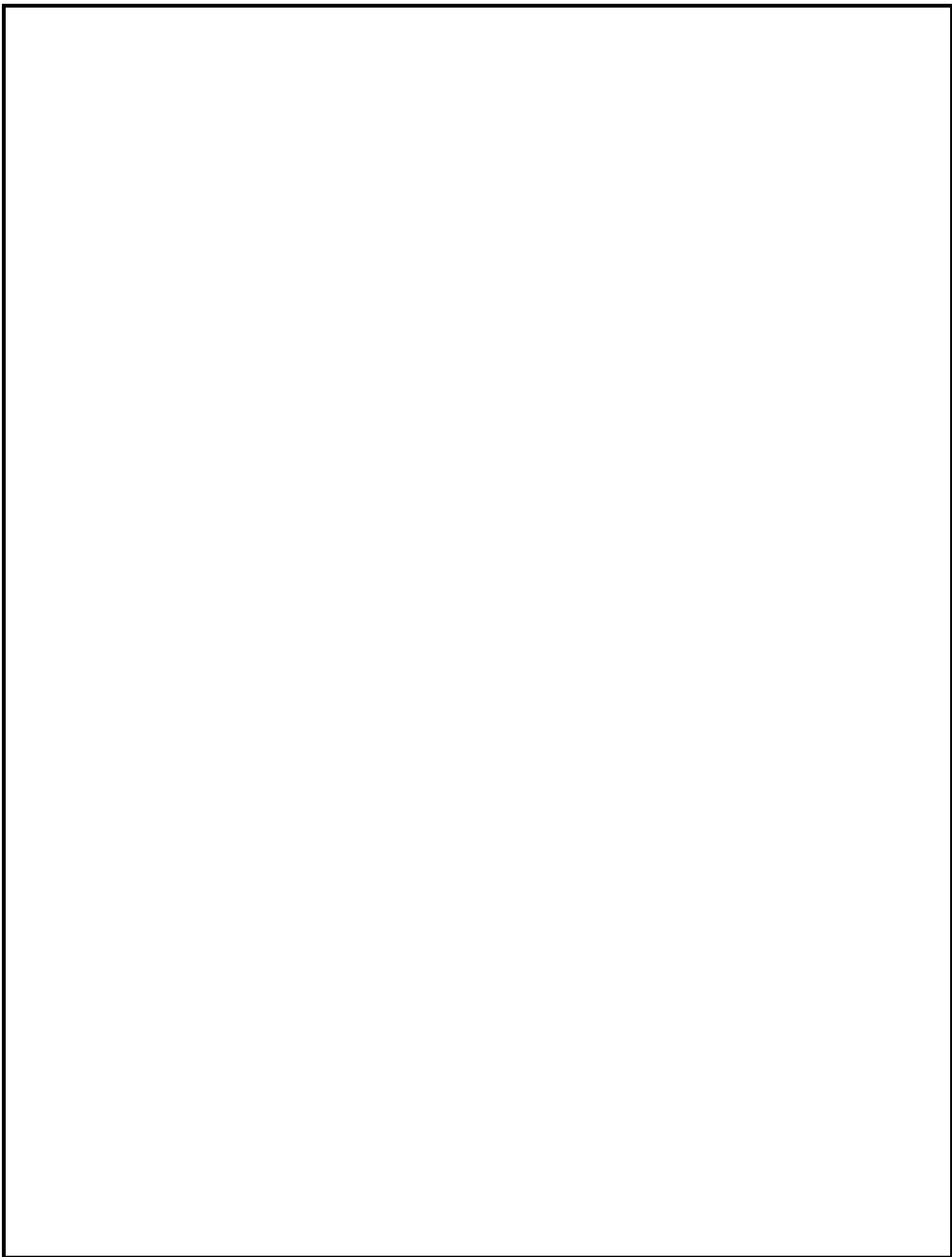
