The Pa. State Fire Academy will be delivering the IFSTA, 80-hour Hazardous Materials Technician Course, with Pro-Board/IFSAC Certification, at the Indiana County Public Safety Academy starting on January 10, 2026, at 8:00 am. Individuals wishing to obtain Certification are required to have completed the State's Certification at the Awareness and Operations levels, prior to completing the Technician Exam. In an effort to obtain these additional levels of Certification, ICPSA will be offering the Awareness and Operations Certification Exams, during the Technician course delivery.

*The HAZMAT Awareness and Operations Exams, will require the submission of a separate application for each exam, along with pre-payment of a test site fee.

There is NO COST for the HAZMAT Technician Course/Certification, as this is a State Fire Academy, Academy on the Road, program. Students will be required to register on the Pa. State Fire Academy's ACADIS Learning Management System website.
